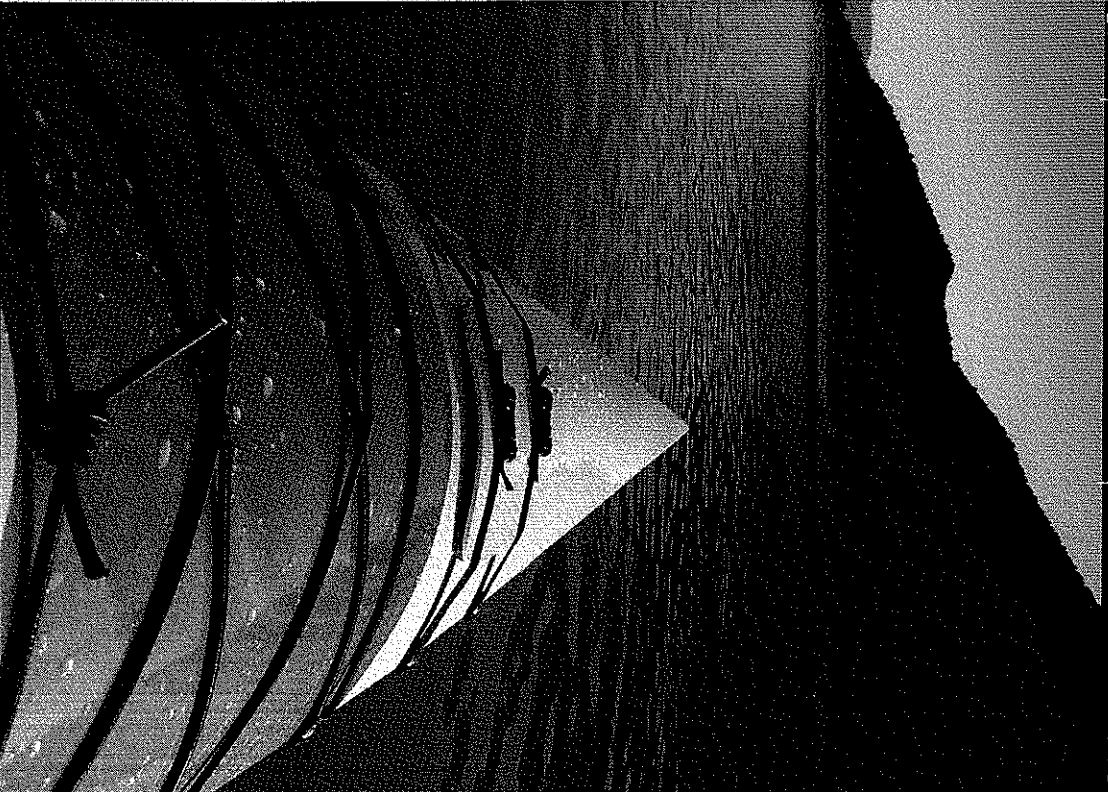

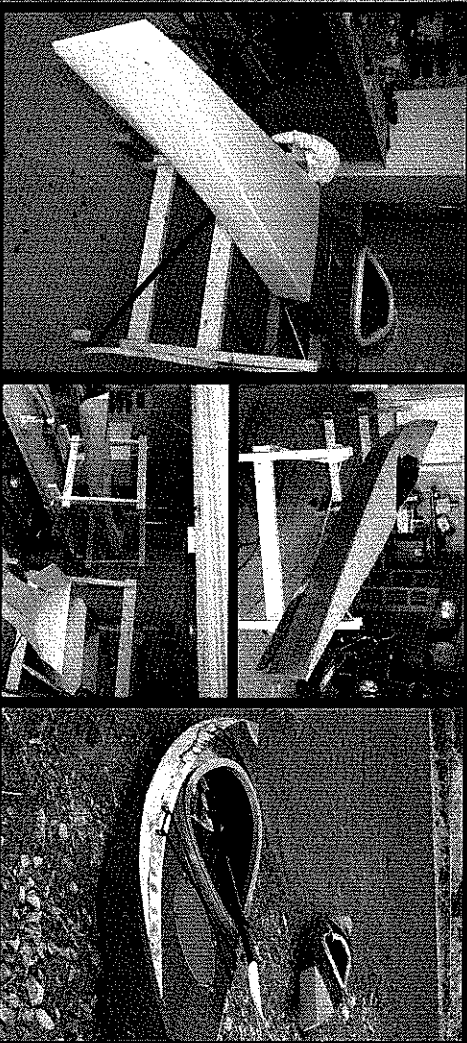

Using the stitch and glue process, Hand Crafted Kayaks of Rifle can build a variety of 25 different kayaks out of 4mm Okoume plywood (a lightweight and durable tropical grown hardwood) and fiberglass cloth. Kayaks are finished with a combination of varnish and marine paint - all to the desired pattern of the client.

Available types of kayaks are recreational, fishing, touring, performance and tandem (two and three person designs). All of these kayaks come in a variety of different styles and sizes, ranging from 8 feet to 21 feet in length. We also offer a few different types of stand-on-top paddle boards.

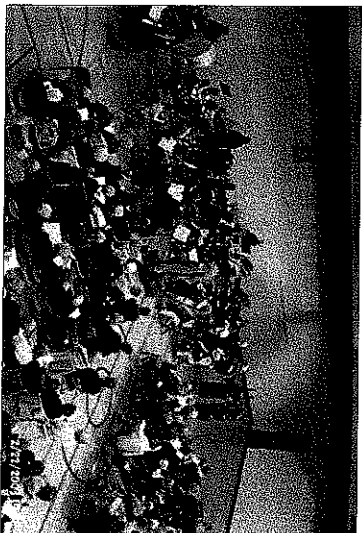
Battlement Mesa Activity Center—The Place Where People Meet

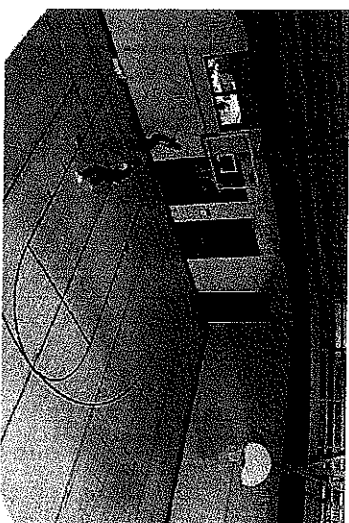
Other formal or informal areas are available for groups of 5—150.

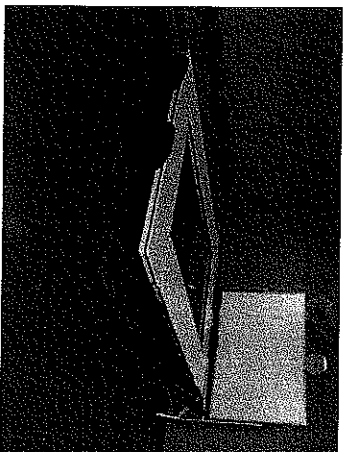

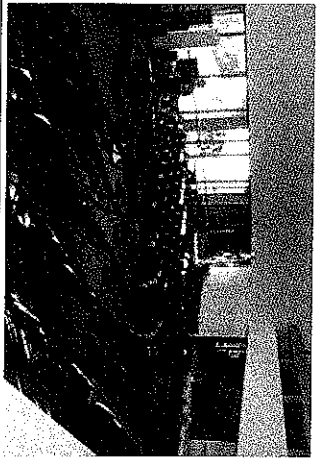


The comfortable Lobby/Living Room welcomes visitors to the Activity Center and encourages informal interaction.

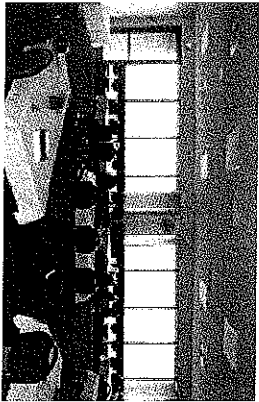

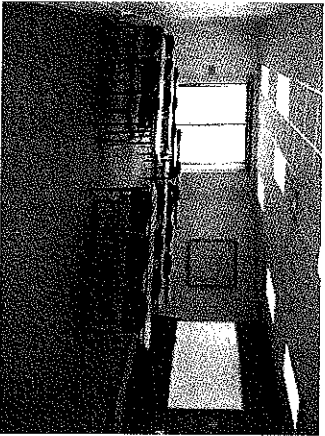

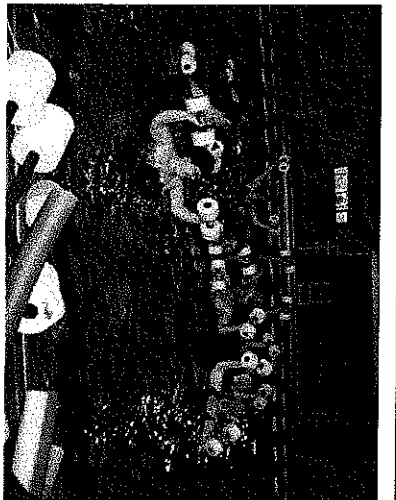
Versatile lobby set up for conference, concerts or wedding. Acoustics are ideal for musical events.



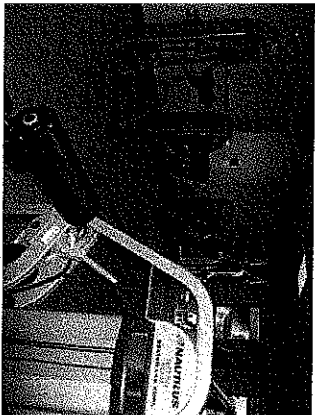
The Community Room, set up banquet style, can accommodate up to 125 guests



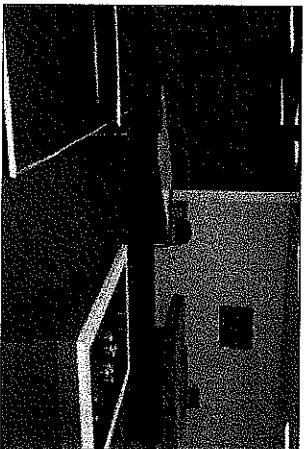
Conference Room I comfortably accommodates groups of about 30 people.
